

SUMMARY DATA FACE-BD

FondaMental Advanced Centre of Expertise – High-Functioning Autism

FACE-BD (FondaMental Advanced Center of Expertise – Bipolar Disorders) is a clinical database built from the electronic medical records of the FondaMental Expert Centers for Bipolar Disorders.

This summary is intended for all teams wishing to access the **FACE-BD** database data to implement, develop, or promote a research project. It summarizes, in a non-exhaustive manner, all the data available in the **FACE-BD** database, categorized by major themes.
